## Getting around in Copenhagen

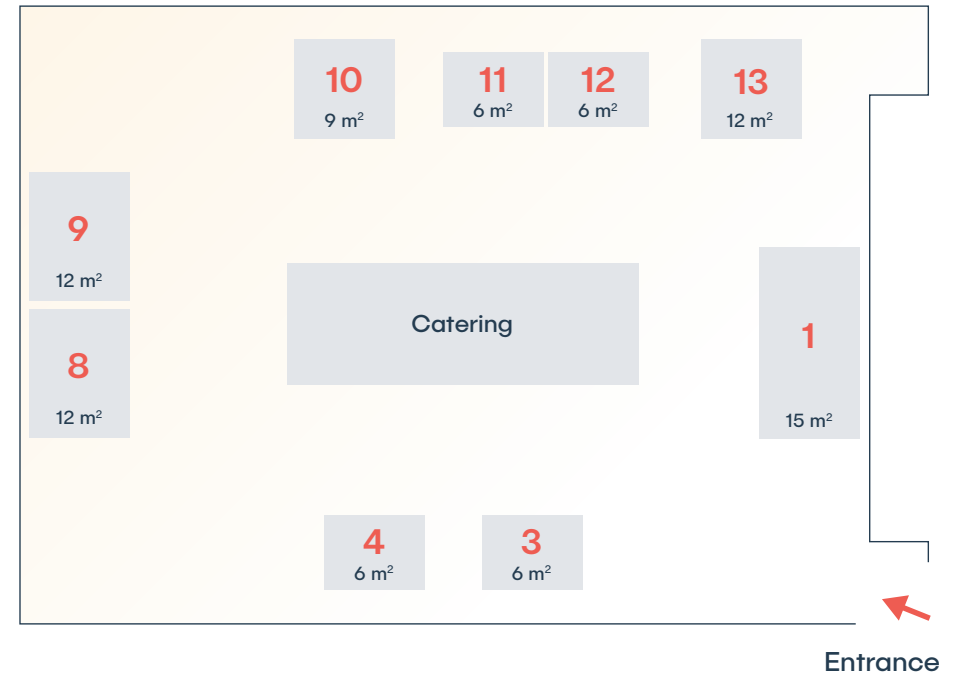
